Sage ESS Saves Time and Money

Most of the company's employees take advantage of the direct deposit option, a feature available within the Sage Abra Suite Payroll module. "Our employees really appreciate that they are able to split their

deposit into multiple accounts," says Jones.

Until recently, Jones and her staff still had to print and distribute the direct deposit vouchers to staff. "We are committed to becoming a paperless department," she says. "We added the Sage ESS module to help us to meet that goal."

The Sage Employee Self Service (Sage ESS) module empowers Eagle Rock Distributing's employees with the ability to access and update much of their own payroll and HR data. They are able to view and print direct deposit pay vouchers, update their address and withholding information, and review and print their W-2 forms.

"The Sage ESS module makes the information available to employees at any time of the day or night," says Jones. "Everyone likes it, particularly our employees who work when our department isn't open. Sage ESS allows them to get the information they need at their convenience."

In addition to providing a service to employees, Sage ESS is saving a considerable amount of time. "We are saving about five hours each week—time we used to spend printing, stuffing, and distributing vouchers. It is a tremendous time-saver," Jones says. "It also is a better business practice—we no longer have printed documents containing sensitive payroll data."

Preventing Check Fraud

Check fraud is an increasing concern for all companies. In response, many banks offer Positive Pay, a service that validates checks submitted for clearing against a customer-provided file of valid check payees and amounts. Eagle Rock Distributing's Sage business partner used Crystal Reports® to create a positive pay report file that contains the data elements in its financial institution's required format. It is sent to the bank after each check run. "We receive a notice from the bank if a check is submitted that does not match the file," explains Jones. "It is so important to have this protection as check fraud becomes more sophisticated."

Specific Business Needs Addressed

To ensure fair pay, Eagle Rock Distributing's management reviews and evaluates employee compensation. A large number of employees receive commission pay, which complicates such analysis. "We need to look at trends in pay, by route, by employee, and by date," explains Jones. In response, the company's Sage business partner developed customized reports that provide management with the information they need to perform the review.

Jones says that Sage Abra Suite HRMS easily handles even the most complex payroll deductions. "We have deductions that involve both an employee and an employer component, such as disability and life insurance," she says. "It is a straightforward process to set these up within the HR module."
